



VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

Social Services Opportunities:

- **Prepare a meal at Fran Conway House on Jefferson Blvd in Warwick or the Men's First Step program on Atwells Ave. in Providence.** Each program serves have 11 units and a kitchen. Come once, or once a week!
- **Assist with check-in and/or meal service at Harrington Hall, a men's emergency overflow shelter in Cranston, 4pm-7pm.** This allows our social services staff more time to actively provide outreach and case management to chronically homeless individuals while you help meet their basic needs, such as handing out blankets or serving dinner. *Must be 18 years or older.*

General Organizational Opportunities:

- **Gardening/landscaping/yard work** (seasonal). Help keep our properties looking their best. This is also a great opportunity for a group volunteer activity.
- **General Office duties.** Help with filing, data entry, etc. Office experience preferred.
- **Office cleaning** (dusting, vacuuming, bathrooms, etc). There may also be cleaning opportunities from time to time at some of our housing units, though generally those are well maintained by residents.
- **Event Planning & fundraising.** Experience required. Opportunities available once or twice a year.

Volunteers agree to complete a brief interview process and may be required to submit to a background check depending on the level of client interaction. Client confidentiality is our priority. House of Hope CDC reserves the right to terminate a volunteer position at any time at our discretion.
